App	<p>This app is designed to help teachers and other professionals who work with young people explain how to keep themselves safe from sexual exploitation. The app follows three male and three female characters through several scenarios that a teenager might face and could potentially lead to abuse – for example, being taken to a party in an unfamiliar place or being asked to send an explicit photograph.
